Topic: Installation- Overview

Travis Air Force Base is an Air Mobility Command (AMC) installation located in Fairfield, Calif.

The primary mission is to provide rapid, responsive, reliable airlift of forces to any point on earth in support of our national objectives and to fulfill the global logistics needs of the Department of Defense in sustaining its world wide activities.

The 60th Air Mobility Wing is the largest organization in AMC and flies the Lockheed C-5 "Galaxy" and the KC-10 "Extender" tanker on a daily operational basis. As host unit for Travis Air Force Base, the 60 AMW controls more than two billion dollars worth of Air Force resources, including aircraft and support facilities, on more than 6,000 acres of land. The 60 AMW consists of four groups: the 60th Operations Group, the 60th Maintenance Group, the 60th Mission Support Group, and the 60th Medical Group (which includes the David Grant USAF Medical Center). Major tenant units include Headquarters Fifteenth Air Force and 349th Air Mobility Wing (Associate).

Reporting In procedures:

If you arrive between 7:00a.m. and 3:30p.m., Monday through Friday, report to the INTRO office (424-2276) in Building 381, Room C102 Customer Service to drop off your personnel records and make your in-processing appointments. If you arrive after duty hours or on a weekend/holiday, the 24 hour arrival point is the Westwind Lodging Office in building 404, 424-8000. See RELOCATION SERVICES, PCS Report Procedures.

Child Care information: See CHILD AND TEEN SERVICES, Child Development Programs - On Installation, and Child Development Programs - Community. Also, AFAS will pay for 20 Hours of child care per child within 60 days of your arrival to Travis. See the Family Support Center for a voucher.

Information on pets: See RELOCATION SERVICES, Pet Boarding, Licensing, Quarantines, Veterinary Services and Pet Transportation.

Important documents to hand carry. Personnel Records, household goods shipping records, financial records, school records.

Cost of living: The cost of living in the vicinity of Travis AFB is generally 11 to 19 per cent above the national average. See RELOCATION SERVICES, Financial Preparedness. For cost of living information See RELOCATION SERVICES, Billeting and Military Acclimate.

Topic: Installation- Directions

Directions from airports:

If you come by commercial airlines through San Francisco International Airport, Oakland International Airport, or Sacramento International Airport THERE IS NO CONTRACTED COMMERCIAL SERVICE BETWEEN THESE POINTS AND TRAVIS. Please make sure to arrange for transportation from airports with the sponsor or insure you have sufficient cash to defray the cost of commercial taxi service. Incoming personnel could require up to \$100.00 to pay for a commercial bus or taxi, which would be reimbursable under most circumstances. See Community Transportation under Local Community for airport shuttle services.

Directions if driving:

Travis is located off Interstate 80 approximately 50 miles northeast of San Francisco and seven miles southeast of Fairfield. I-80 runs between San Francisco and Sacramento and goes through Fairfield and Vacaville. The interstate brings traffic from the east through Reno, Nev. to Sacramento and 40 miles further to Fairfield. The easiest access to the base is to take the Air Base Parkway turnoff. This leads directly to the front gate. Traveling from the north, the best approach route would be on Interstate 5 to Interstate 505 which will intersect with I-80 in Vacaville, just north of Travis. From Los Angeles and other southwest and southern points, the approach would be on Interstate 5 or California Highway 99. Take I-5 14 miles past Stockton to California Highway 12. From there it is approximately 46 miles to Fairfield. Taking Highway 99, turnoff at Lodi onto Highway 12. From Lodi, it is 54 miles to Fairfield. Upon arriving in Fairfield, take Walters Road east to Air Base Parkway.

Topic: Installation- Check-in Procedures

When you move you need to notify DEERS of your new address. You can do this at Military Personnel Flight and request to update your DEERS information. You can also mail your change of address to the DEERS Support Office, call them toll free, or e-mail them. If you arrive between 7:00a.m. and 3:30p.m., Monday - Friday, report to the INTRO office in Customer Service to drop off your personnel records and make your in-processing appointments. If you arrive after duty hours or on a weekend/holiday, the 24 hour arrival point is the Westwind Lodging Office.

Ask for permissive TDY for house hunting if you have not already taken it.

Topic: Installation- Vehicle Regulations

Car Insurance: You can expect to pay between \$50 and \$150 per month for full coverage car insurance.

Base vehicle registration: Register your vehicle on base through your unit orderly room. An I.D. Card, current vehicle registration, a current driver's license from any state and a smog certificate is required to register your vehicle on base. If married, your spouse (if not active duty) must obtain a California driver's license within ten days of employment within the state.

Motorcycle registration is processed through the 60 Security Forces Squadron's Pass & ID desk in bldg 381, down the hall from MPF Customer Service. Required items include:

60 AMW Form 32 from your Squadron Motorcycle Safety Rep,
drivers license, proof of insurance, motorcycle card from MSF:RSS Class, current registration, and an ID card

Fishing License (State)	Fishing licenses are sold at the Information, Travel, and Tours Office, most sporting goods stores, bait shops, and many super markets. Make sure you know what type of fish you want and how you are going to fish for them. There are different tags for each.

Parking lights: It is against the law to drive with only parking lights on, at any time, day or night.

All others may register their vehicles through Pass and Registration or at the Visitor Control facility at the main gate. They must present their I.D. card, vehicle registration, California smog certificate, and proof of insurance. Vehicles registered in other states but owned by military personnel on active duty in California must obtain a smog inspection in order to obtain a base access decal. Issuance of a certificate of compliance (California) is not required, but the vehicle owner must present a Passed VIR (Vehicle Inspection Report) as proof of inspection to obtain the base access decal. If the vehicle was registered in other than the member's home state (state in which last assigned), a waiver is granted until the tags require annual renewal. For non-California residents, if the member completes a Certificate of Military Exemption, they can become exempt from the portion of the regular licensing fees normally collected in lieu of personal property tax. In California this is entitled the "Vehicle License Fee". Vehicles registered in other states but owned by military personnel on active duty in California must obtain a smog inspection in order to obtain a base access decal. Topic: Local Community- Weather

Travis' weather is uniquely driven by its location between the cool California coast, the coastal mountains and the Sacramento Valley. The climate across central California can be very diverse almost any day of the year. On any summer day, conditions can range from drizzle and 50 degrees in San Francisco to sunny and 105 degrees in Sacramento to thunderstorms in the Sierra foothills. Along the same path in winter, you may experience comfortable sunshine in the foothills or sub-zero blizzard in the Sierra mountains. Being at the mouth of an opening in the coastal hills, a funneling effect of the wind can keep a steady southwest wind blowing at 15-20 knots for several days, any month of the year. In summer, this wind can be a relief to the 100 degree heat that can be experienced if winds die down. It is not uncommon to have persistent fog for a week straight throughout the Sacramento Valley during winter months. It is the diversity of the weather, and activities in the surrounding areas that can offer so much to a large number of people throughout the year. Many Travis families choose to live off-base in nearby communities. The living accommodations range from apartments to single-family subdivisions to upscale estates. The majority of Travis people live in closer areas such as Fairfield and Vacaville; some, however, prefer to live as far away as San Francisco, the Napa Valley, and Sacramento. This section will introduce you to the areas most convenient for Travis families, and also to the outlying communities where many choose to live and play. It will also give you an introduction to Northern California, with emphasis on the areas and activities that are within a reasonable distance of Travis.

FAIRFIELD and SUISUN CITY

Fairfield and Suisun (pronounced Sue soon) City are twin cities adjoining Travis, and are situated halfway between San Francisco and Sacramento on Interstate 80. Fairfield, the County Seat of Solano County, is growing rapidly due to its expanding commercial and industrial base. Solano County as a whole has a population well over 400,000, according to recent estimates.

The median home price for this area ranges from \$185,000 to \$300,000. Apartments in the area rent from \$850 to \$1,450 per month. Rural home sites and senior citizen housing are also available. New housing subdivisions and apartment complexes are continuously under construction, giving the Fairfield-Suisun dweller a variety of options when selecting a place to live.

The Fairfield-Suisun Unified School system boasts modern facilities for all ages, ranging from elementary through high school. It offers a full range of academic programs, including an adult school for those wishing to continue or complete their high school education.

A diverse selection of recreational outlets are available for all age groups, including theaters, public parks, playgrounds, swimming pools, and community centers. For the nautically-minded, Suisun City's public and private marinas have boat launching facilities and a gateway through the Suisun Slough to the waterways of Suisun Bay, the California Delta, and San Francisco Bay. The Fairfield-Suisun area also boasts an excellent hospital, library, daily newspaper, AMTRAK railway station, a variety of financial institutions, and churches representing many denominations.

VACAVILLE

Vacaville is located about seven miles north of Travis, straddling Interstate 80 in Solano County. Interstate 505, the Sacramento bypass for traffic moving between the San Francisco Bay area and the interior of Northern California and the Oregon border originates in Vacaville and joins Interstate 5 approximately 30 miles north of the town. The population is over 89,000. Single-family homes sell for \$250,000 and up. Typical rental costs for one and two bedroom apartment range from \$850 to \$1400 per month.

The Vacaville Unified School District operates numerous public educational facilities which provide a variety of learning experiences for the Vacaville student. Those wishing to balance their education with recreation will find golf, parks, playgrounds, public library, theater facilities, and a senior citizens center.

Getting around in Vacaville can be done with ease, as the city is served by both bus and rail transportation, and has a county maintained airport suitable for charter and general aviation uses.

Many organizations have branches in Vacaville. All of the major national service clubs are represented, and there are also many active civic groups. Vacaville is also home to a local newspaper and radio station, several financial institutions, and a variety of churches representing many faiths.

SOLANO COUNTY

Some Travis families have chosen to live in other areas of Solano County, and the following is a brief overview of some of the communities. Vallejo is the largest city in Solano County, with over 117,300 residents, and lies on San Pablo Bay at the mouth of the Napa River. It is located 30 miles from Travis and 30 miles from San Francisco. Vallejo serves as a busy port and processing center for farm products, and is the area's principal commercial and service center. The waterfront area has been recently redeveloped, and is an anchorage for two counties and a launching place for small boats. The historic city of Benicia, population 28,200, overlooks the Carquinez Strait. New neighborhoods with well-groomed homes rest among the rolling hills and blend with the older historic structures of the city below.

About 20 miles southeast of Travis is Rio Vista, population about 5,000, lying at the opening of the beautiful Sacramento River. It is the gateway to more than 1,200 miles of delta waterways, and borders on one of the state's largest hunting areas for fowl.

Twenty miles up Interstate 80 toward Sacramento is Dixon, a livestock and farming center. In recent years the population has grown to over 17,100, but the area still maintains its charming small town atmosphere.

OTHER AREAS

Some Travis people have chosen to live outside Solano County, despite the longer commute. South of Carquinez Strait is Contra Costa County. The east bay communities of Concord and Walnut Creek are home to some Travis families, but are most often considered to be bedroom communities for Oakland and San Francisco. North of San Francisco lies scenic Marin County. Some Travis people who enjoy the energy of the city make their homes here, in places such as Mill Valley and San Rafael. North and west of Travis are Napa and Sonoma Counties, both within commuting distance. This is the area known as California's wine country. It has been growing steadily in recent years, but has managed to remain scenic, rural, and inviting.

About eight miles east of Dixon on Interstate 80 is Davis, population 55,600, home of the University of California. U.C. Davis has several well known graduate and undergraduate programs, and is one of the most popular in the U.C. system. Davis is an individualistic city with many unique and innovative features, and has a national reputation for its environmental awareness.

At one hour's drive, Sacramento is about the maximum commute for people from Travis. This thriving city with a population of 500,000 is located 14 miles east of Davis, and is well known for the superior quality of life its residents enjoy. Besides being the state capital, it boasts some of the finest in culture, recreation, shopping, and education.

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

Northern California is so varied that it has something for practically everyone. The topography boasts a scenic coastline, rugged mountains, and flat, lush valleys. The climate is generally moderate and conducive to a high quality of life. There are large cities with urban amenities, farm areas that feed the country, undeveloped expanses of forests, and variety of outdoor recreational areas to be explored. What follows are highlights of some of the attractions of this area, so that families may seek out activities that suit their own personal interests.

San Francisco, the hub of Northern California, has a population in excess of 750,000. It is a vital industrial, shipping, and financial center, and also a mecca for tourists, who come for the fine restaurants, shopping, and cultural activities. Travis receives radio and television broadcasts from San Francisco, and many subscribe to the San Francisco newspapers as a supplement to local papers from outlying areas.

For selection of prime leisure time activities, San Francisco can't be beat. There are opera, symphony, and ballet companies of national renown that perform throughout the year, and the theatre community is strong and flourishing. Nightclubs offer a vast selection of music and entertainment, and the local area museums generate excitement with both permanent collections and traveling exhibitions. For sports fans, the bay area has two race courses, two baseball teams, two football teams, and a basketball team.

North of the bay are Muir Woods National Monument and Point Reyes National Seashore. Traveling up the coast, one finds scenic beauty, fishing villages, quaint villages, resorts, and artists' colonies. The Russian River region is a popular scenic and recreational area, and still further north is Redwood National Park, home of the world famous majestic redwood trees. Closer to Travis is the Sonoma/Napa wine country and its popular winery tours. Sacramento has restored its historical area, and shops and museums provide both education and entertainment for visitors. North and east of the capital are the Feather River country, Sierra Nevada mountain range, and the Mother Lode country. All of these areas excel in scenery, history, and recreation. The great Central Valley stretches southward as one of the great farming regions of the country. South of San Francisco is the Monterey Peninsula, noted for its picturesque landscape and charming towns. Further south is the wild, beautiful area known as Big Sur, and the famous Hearst Castle in San Simeon.

Northern California abounds in recreational opportunities. Water sports are prevalent throughout the area, from the Pacific Ocean to the lakes and reservoirs of the interior. Lake Berryessa, just north of Vacaville, and other waterways are excellent for those who like to water ski, sail, fish, raft, and dive. The Sierra Nevada mountain range is a summer and winter playground, and is particularly noted for its abundance of quality ski areas. There are approximately 25 million acres of public lands suitable for camping, hiking, cycling, and horseback riding. In addition to the areas already mentioned, there are also King's Canyon, Lassen Volcanic, Sequoia and Yosemite National Parks, Golden Gate National Recreation Area, and numerous forests, trails, and wilderness areas.

Only domesticated dogs, cats, and caged birds may be maintained at Travis AFB, and it is required to register your pets with the Base Veterinary Office, Building 543. For information, please call them at 424-3010. Other pets require written approval from the 60 MSG/CC. Exotic pets are not allowed (iguanas, snakes, etc.) See Travis AFB Instruction 31-102 "Control of Animals on Travis AFB" at the Travis home web page at the dot mil web site under the title "Forms and Publications" for rules governing pets maintained on base. Only one pet (cat or dog under 20 pounds) will be allowed in the Build/Lease complex/George Town (Patriot Village) and the Travis Townhouses/Onizuka Flats. The effective date of the application is the first of the month prior to the arrival month. This is the month the member is reporting for duty. All officer family housing is adequate three or four bedroom homes. Applications may be made in advance. There are several different waiting lists, depending on the member's rank and bedroom requirement. The waiting periods for base housing are subject to change. See Below

ADVANCE HOUSING APPLICATIONS. All military personnel with dependents, are authorized to submit an advance application for military housing at any time after they have received PCS or Active Duty orders for Travis AFB. The application must be submitted on DD Form 1746, Application for Assignment to Housing.

The effective date of application is the first day of the month prior to the month in which the applicant states he or she will arrive at the gaining installation - - this is the actual reporting or sign-in month. If the applicant arrives at Travis AFB later than the stated arrival month, the effective date of application is adjusted to the first day of the month prior to the actual reporting arrival month.

If the applicant arrives at Travis prior to the stated arrival month, he/she has the option of retaining the original effective date of application, or assuming a "walk-in date".

The advance application must be received by Housing Management Flight prior to the first day of the "reporting month." If not received prior to this date, the effective date is the first day of the reporting month.

PRIORITY ASSIGNMENT TO BASE HOUSING. Key and essential positions are covered in AFI 32-6001. Priority assignment to on-base housing for either medical or financial hardship reasons must be supported by the appropriate base agencies.

SINGLE PERSONNEL. All single personnel grades E-5 and above will be required to obtain quarters off base. Recommend utilization of the Travis Housing Office's off base referral service to expedite location of suitable quarters.

All single personnel grades E-4 and below are required to reside in the Travis AFB dormitory facilities. Upon arrival contact your squadron orderly room to secure a dormitory room. (NOTE: Bulk items (furniture and excess household items) cannot be stored in dormitory room. You may utilize Non-Temporary Storage for storage of bulk items at no cost. For hotels and motels that accommodate pets, see Community Housing. Rabies: dogs and cats must be vaccinated against rabies at least 30 days prior to entry into the United States, except puppies and kittens less than 3 months of age and dogs and cats originating or located for 6 months or more in areas designated by the Public Health Service as being rabies free. No quarantines in California. AMC charters will ship only dogs and cats at the owners expense and is limited to charter passengers in a permanent change of station status. The limit is two pets per family; waivers are required for more than two pets. There is also a weight limit which is 99 pounds, including the cage or shipping container. Owners are responsible for the preparation and care of their animals and satisfying all documentation, immunization and border clearance requirements, including quarantines. The shipping container used must be approved by the International Air Transport Association and be large enough for normal body movements and for the pet to stand up, turn around and lie down comfortably. A small pet can travel in the charter aircraft cabin with special permission from AMC, but it must be in a hard-shell kennel not exceeding 20" X 16" X 8". Passengers must make arrangements two or three months before they are scheduled to move. Topic: Local Community- Truck Rental

You may also use rental trucks and/or trailers to make your Personally Procured Transportation move. It is your responsibility to make arrangements with the rental company of your choice. We recommend that you shop around for the best rates and equipment. The TMO/JPPSO is not authorized to make referrals or recommendations as to which rental company you should choose.

If you plan to haul a rental trailer, be aware that temporary rental trailer hitches can not always be mounted on late model cars. Prior to placing an order with the rental dealer, you should verify that the temporary hitch would fit on the vehicle to be used, or verify that the factory-installed hitch is suitable for use with rental trailers.

Most truck-rental agencies provide familiarization, operation, and safety training on trucks and associated equipment. This training is critical because the member is liable while operating the rental vehicle, which is similar to a POV to perform the move. Rental agencies and the Government are not responsible for training drivers in operating leased vehicles.

Topic: Local Community- Customs

A special provision allows U.S. Government personnel (military and civilian) to enter their personal and household effects without payment of duty and tax when returning from an extended duty assignment overseas even if those effects have not been in the household for at least a year before importation into the U.S. as is required for returning residents. The personal and household effects of any person (military or civilian) employed by the U.S. Government, and members of his/her family who have resided with him/her at his/her post or station and are returning to the U.S. with orders, may be entered free of duty unless items are restricted, prohibited, or limited as in the case of liquor and tobacco. It is not necessary for the goods to have been in their household at least 1 year in order to qualify for duty free status, but they must have been in the owner's physical possession before shipping. Goods shipped directly to the U.S. from a factory do not qualify for duty free entry.

The following groups of people are not entitled to this exemption: employees of private business and commercial organizations working under contract for the U.S. Government, persons under research fellowships granted by the United States Government, Peace Corps volunteers, employees of UNICEF or the Red Cross, or persons going abroad under the Fulbright-Hays Act of 1961 or under the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act of 1961.

Education

California provides a one-year tuition waiver for the spouse and dependents of active duty military personnel while attending community colleges. During that time, the non-military spouse and dependents are entitled to one year of in-state tuition. For example, Solano Community College charges California residents an enrollment fee of \$12 per unit. Out of state residents pay that fee plus \$125 per unit tuition.

If you are moving to another state you may want to find out how testing requirements could affect your child. School and state education department Web sites have information on test requirements. Places to start:

New students are requested to provide copies of transfer papers or report cards from their previous school, verification of address (i.e., PG&E, cable, or water bill if it has a name and address on the bill), and up-to-date immunization records.

Age requirements for California public schools are:

Kindergarten: Child must be 5 years old on 2 Dec of the school year. Birth certificates are required for students enrolling in Kindergarten or students new to the state.

First grade: Child must be 6 years old on 2 Dec of the school year. Physical examinations are required for students enrolling in first grade.

High school graduation requirements for the state of California are:

English - 3 courses, Physical Education - 2 courses, Mathematics - 2 courses, Science - 2 courses, including biological and physical sciences, Social Science - 3 courses, Foreign language or visual or performing arts - 1 course.

David Grant Medical Center is a state-of-the-art medical facility serving 750,000 military beneficiaries in the eight western states. A far cry from the original Fairfield-Suisun Base Hospital first opened in 1943, the present medical center was completed in 1988 at a cost of \$193 million.

The facility operated by the 60th Medical Group encompasses 808,475 square feet with 3,662 rooms, approximately 200 inpatient and 75 aeromedical staging flight beds, 52 dental treatment rooms, and serves 400,000 patients annually. The four story structure is divided into three patient zones - inpatient nursing units, diagnostic and treatment areas, and outpatient clinics. The hospital is designed around five large courtyards and is greater than two football fields in width and almost four football fields in length.

Design and construction of the medical center was accomplished through a unique design-build contract, which enabled the project to be completed ahead of schedule and \$8 million below original budget projections. The facility has received five national awards for design and construction, is built to withstand major earthquakes (seismic 4), and can operate for up to a week using internal utility capabilities.

The medical center offers a complete range of medical, surgical and dental services. Including magnetic resonance imaging, nuclear medicine and a world-class hyperbaric medicine service. These services are supported by an active clinical investigations program as well as extensive post-graduate training programs in medicine, dentistry, nursing and health care administration.

A "typical day" at David Grant involves 31 admissions, 158 inpatients, 3 births, 16 operations, 1,152 clinic visits, 6,245 laboratory procedures and 2,178 prescriptions. The medical center is currently staffed by 1,363 military and 238 civilian personnel. When David Grant Medical Center opened its doors in Dec 88, it marked the beginning of a new era in health care at Travis. Travis members and their families have available to them one of the most modern health care facilities in the nation.

David Grant also has two off-site out-patient clinics located in Sacramento approximately 50 miles from Travis. The McClellan Clinic and the Mather Clinic both fall under the Medical Operations Squadron, DSN 799-3820 or 707 423-3820.

The David Grant Medical Center uses an "automated attendant" telephone system to provide patients a convenient and quick method for scheduling and canceling most outpatient appointments. This system automatically answers all incoming calls and automatically routes each call to the correct appointment service phone extension.

Patients should dial DSN 799 Comm (707)423-3000 [(800)264-3462 if long distance] to make or cancel an appointment in all outpatient clinics except Mental Health Clinic (DSN 799 Comm 423-5174), Hematology Oncology Clinic (DSN 799 Comm 423-5129), and the Flight Surgeon Office (DSN 799 Comm 423-5446). All calls to DSN 799 Comm 423-3000 will automatically be answered by a voice message, and callers will be transferred by "touch-tone" responses through a series of voice messages to the correct appointment service. Patients can cancel an appointment 24 hours a day, seven days a week by leaving a recorded message at the appropriate cancellation service.

Patients requiring emergency treatment should report to the Emergency Room located on the second floor, west wing on the clinic side. Directional signs are located on the base and on Bodin Road (the perimeter road around the clinic) and clearly indicate the proper route

to the Emergency Room.

Emergency ambulance service is provided by the Emergency Department for emergencies occurring on Travis Air Force Base only. When an emergency occurs on Travis dial 911 and request to be patched through to the Emergency Room. Ambulance needs for off-base purposes are provided through civilian ambulance services by dialing 911. Two information desks are located within the medical center, one at the south entrance and one at the north entrance. These provide assistance for obtaining directions to various departments, telephone numbers, and general information regarding the medical center. Hours of operation for the south out-patient information desk are 8:00a.m. - 4:00p.m., phone DSN 799 Comm 423-3687. Hours of operation for the north in-patient information desk are 8:00a.m. - 8:00p.m., phone DSN 799 Comm 423-7300.

Ensure availability of services for family members of active duty military personnel in the event of a PCS move. 2. Assists families with relocation when a medical or special education condition exists and services are not available at the current or PCS location. 3. Assist families in finding needed resources both on base and in the community. A medical special need means that the family member requires specialized medical care (urology, neurology, psychiatry, developmental pediatrics, etc.) for an ongoing, chronic illness. An educational special need means that a family member requires special educational services in order to progress academically. These services are identified in an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individualized Family Service Plan and may include resource rooms, psychological services, occupational or physical therapy, and/or adaptive equipment. Enrollment is mandatory for all active duty military personnel who have a family member with a special need. SNIAC personnel can help to ensure needed services will be available, on or off base, prior to a PCS move. They can also help with SNIAC reassignments and deferments. The Air Force ensures families with special needs are assigned to locations where required services are available. Family Member Relocation Clearance (FMRC) is a screening process used to identify special needs and determine the availability of services at projected locations. The SNIAC process does not affect who is eligible for PCS, TDY, or mobility. Enrollment will continue as long as a special need exists. The Air Force provides a package of benefits and allowances for relocating personnel and their families, from housing to spouse employment assistance. The Relocation Assistance Program provides concrete aid to help minimize the impact of mobility on the emotional and physical well being of the Air Force Family. 1. IF YOU ARE SEPARATING OR BEING DISCHARGED, the Port Separation Section will process you only on a duty day, Monday through Friday. We are closed on Saturday, Sunday and all holidays. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT TO SEPARATIONS SECTION, BUILDING 381, NO LATER THAN 7:30a.m. ON THE FIRST DUTY DAY AFTER ARRIVAL IN CONUS. ALL PERSONNEL ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN UNIFORM AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH AFI 36-2903.

Please be aware that unless you are going on terminal leave, your date of separation is the day you process at port. (See paragraph 4 on "Insuring your out processing is easy")

2. IF YOU ARE RETIRING, REPORT TO SEPARATIONS/RETIREMENT SECTION, BUILDING 381, ON THE FIRST DUTY DAY AFTER ARRIVAL IN CONUS, IN UNIFORM. DROP YOUR SEALED RETIREMENT PACKAGE OFF IN THE RETIREMENT UNIT.

You will have a finance briefing which will last for about two hours. After this briefing, please see our retirement specialist who will assist you in reviewing your DD Form 214 Worksheet and accomplishing other actions.

YOUR LOSING MPF SHOULD HAVE ADVISED YOU TO ARRIVE 3-5 DUTY DAYS PRIOR TO DOS OR START OF TERMINAL LEAVE FOR RETIREMENT PROCESSING. This requirement is established by AFI 36-3203. You will not be permitted to depart the area/clear the base until your retirement date or until the start of your approved terminal leave date. Many retirees have made the mistake of arriving at port too early and were disappointed when they were not permitted to depart/clear the base early.

3. A TYPICAL PROCESSING DAY. If you are separating or being discharged, we can complete your processing in one day in most cases.

7:30a.m. - 8:00a.m. We will have you fill out a few forms and collect all records given to you by your overseas MPF. Be sure to bring all records with you. Also bring a pen. Your base Separations Unit will give you a package which contains your Personnel records, Finance records, Medical/Dental records.

8:00a.m. - 9:00a.m. Finance Briefing. You will fill out a travel voucher and other finance forms. You should ask any questions you might have concerning your travel pay entitlements and final pay at this time.

YOU ARE REQUESTED TO HAVE ANY PAY PROBLEMS RESOLVED AT YOUR CURRENT STATION PRIOR TO ARRIVING HERE FOR FINAL PROCESSING. YOU WILL RECEIVE NO MONEY OTHER THAN TRAVEL PAY IF YOU HAVE ANY PAY PROBLEMS. THE FINANCE OFFICE WILL MAIL YOU A CHECK WITHIN SIX WEEKS AFTER SEPARATION IF YOU HAVE ANY PAY PROBLEMS THAT CAN'T BE TAKEN CARE OF DURING YOUR PROCESSING.

9:00a.m. - 10:00a.m. Records Review. You will assist our separations specialists with a final review of your DD Form 214 Worksheet and complete paperwork for ID card retrieval.

10:00a.m. - 1:00p.m. Free time. We need this time to prepare your separations orders and DD Form 214. You can use this time to check out of billeting, get something to eat, or attend to travel arrangements (Read the section on insuring your out processing is easy).

1:00p.m. Report to Finance, Building 381, Wing F-2 for final pay and travel pay.

3:00p.m. - 5:00p.m. Report to our Separation Briefing room, Building 381 for receipt of final separation documentation. Don't forget a pen, your ID card, and your dependent's ID cards.

THIS SCHEDULE MAY VARY, DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF PERSONNEL HERE TO PROCESS. WE WILL LET YOU KNOW ON THE DAY YOU PROCESS HOW LONG IT WILL TAKE TO FINISH PROCESSING. DO NOT MAKE ANY ARRANGEMENTS TO LEAVE PRIOR TO 5:00p.m.

4. INSURING YOUR OUT PROCESSING IS EASY. BELOW ARE THE MOST COMMON AREAS OF DISAGREEMENT WITH SOME SEPARATEES. REMEMBER THAT BEING AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAN SAVE ALL OF US TIME, AND MAYBE EVEN SAVE YOU SOME MONEY.

Things will go easier for you if you are able to arrange for arrival on a week day. Arriving on Friday or on the weekend might be very inconvenient for you since you must wait until Monday or Tuesday (if Monday is a holiday) to process out. If you arrive later than your required reporting time on Friday morning, you will not be processed until the next duty day. That means you must have sufficient money on hand to pay for lodging and food. You won't be receiving any money from our finance office until at least 1:00p.m. on the day you process out.

A WORD OF CAUTION BEFORE MAKING TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS - If you are being separated, and have not completed at least 90% of your first enlistment you will not be receiving full travel pay. You will receive only 75% of the money for travel. (Example - Say you enlisted for 4 years and now being involuntarily separated, you must complete at least 3 years and 7 months and 6 days of this enlistment to collect full travel pay. If you completed less than 3 years and 7 months and 6 days of your first enlistment you will be receiving less travel money-25% less).

If you are being involuntarily separated, first term or career, and are receiving a "Under Other Than Honorable" discharge, you also will receive only 75% of normal travel pay, regardless of your time in service. We mention this now because we suggest that you go to the Military Travel Section, located in the terminal across from N & N Travel and Tours, during your free time. Check to see what type of travel you can be provided. They may be able to send you home by bus or by plane. Do not take a TR at this time, you will be going to the Travel Section at Finance at 1:00p.m., or shortly after. They will tell you how much travel money you will receive. At this time you can decide if you want to take the money or if you would rather have a TR. You can't have both.

Please pay close attention to the total number of days leave you have. You can sell 60 days leave only if you have not sold any leave since 10 Feb 1976. If you have, we suggest that you take terminal leave.

Reserve Officers are authorized Travel days (Travel computed from Port Facility, and is based on 350 miles per day) to your Home of Record. You must return to the CONUS Port in sufficient time to allow completion of authorized travel before effective date of separation. Involuntary separating reserve officers are not authorized travel time.

Your DD Form 214 (Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty) is one of the most important documents you will receive in your military career. But it will only be as up-to-date as the information we receive from your MPF and you. The following will help us both.

- a. That a new record review RIP is received (within 30 days of departure).
- b. That all your awards and decorations are accounted for.
- c. That you review and understand what is on your DD Form 214 worksheet; any errors are corrected before you depart.
- d. Your rank is correct and a source document is in your records.
- e. That your Home of Record and Place of Entry into active duty is correct.
- f. Certificate of completion of military education are available if you wish to have them on your DD Form 214.

Go to your postal service center and fill out a change of address card. All of your personal mail will be forwarded to you from that facility if you do. Make sure that you give your base Separations Unit and unit of assignment a valid future mailing address prior to your departure. They will ensure that any official documentation is forwarded on to you. DO NOT USE US AS A FORWARDING ADDRESS. You will eliminate any delays in receiving your mail if you follow these tips.

5. RECORDS - MEDICAL/DENTAL/PERSONNEL AND COPIES. We simply do not have the time nor resources to give every person copies of documents upon request. Because of this, we will not copy documents for you. We suggest that you have any medical documents copied at your medical facility, and have the MPF Customer Service unit get you the copies of documents out of your personnel records. Be sure to request all copies well in advance of your departure. You may be denied copies just because of timing if you don't. Also, you may be charged for any copies made. Your dental records will be mailed directly to HQ ARPC or HQ AFPC by your overseas MPF; you will not handcarry these records. If you are applying for VA claim, for dental reasons your records will be forwarded to us. If applying for VA claim (Disability) and the claim form is submitted to us, your medical records will be forwarded to the VA Regional Office near your home of record.

RESERVE/ANG MEMBERS (with assignment) Records are sent to your Reserve/ANG unit. If an AF Form 1288 is completed prior to date of separation.

YOUR DEPENDENT RECORDS - We suggest that you pick them up from your medical and dental clinics. If you are retiring we suggest that you turn them in to a medical facility near your home. If you're separating take them with you.

6. A WORD FROM THE RESERVE RECRUITER. Our Reserve counselor is located in Bldg 381. You can visit on the day you come in for port processing and receive all up-to-date information concerning joining the Air Force Reserves. You can obtain an assignment to a unit near your home, if available. If you are interested in retraining, you can get immediate possibilities. Information and openings change constantly.

Who can apply for the Reserves? Officers and all enlisted personnel who have been recommended for reenlistment.

PORT SEPARATIONS INFORMATION FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO ENTER THE RESERVES.

a. People who have completed their military service obligation (MSO)

(1) If you haven't had a Separation Physical, then you'll need an AF Form 422 and SF 93 that are dated within 90 days of your DOS. (NOTE - THE 422 MUST SHOW CURRENT HEIGHT AND WEIGHT.)

(2) If you know where you are moving and have the 422/93 or Separation Physical, then you can mail these along with a Record Review RIP that is less than 90 days old at your DOS to - 60 MSS/MSPH (RES), TRAVIS AFB, CA. 94535-5000

b. People who still have an MSO

(1) If you know where you are moving, you can send a Record Review RIP 90 - 100 days prior to your DOS to the above address.

(2) There should be time to work out a Reserve assignment through the mail. If you complete an AF Form 1288 when you arrive at Travis for out processing, the whole transition from the Active Duty to the Reserve would be much smoother.

c. For all people going into the Reserve.

(1) Each person must be within weight standards. (2) Each person who accepts a Reserve assignment must report to the unit of assignment on the date the gaining unit tells him/her unless other arrangements have been made.

(3) Not all AFSC's are available at all locations, therefore some individuals must retrain into another AFSC. (NOTE - As long as there are openings, the individual's physical profile doesn't disqualify him/her and the ASVAB scores are qualifying then an individual can cross train into another AFSC in the Reserve).
